

# NAIDOC ROUND: CLUB CHECKLIST

This checklist provides a range of ways clubs can acknowledge NAIDOC Round, you don't need to do everything.

## Planning / Pre-Game

- Check NAIDOC Week theme.
- Engage First Nations players, families & Elders.
- Include opposition club in planning.
- Welcome to Country / Acknowledgement of Country.
- Smoking Ceremony.
- First Nations players as captains / coin toss leaders.
- Education session or Cultural Awareness talk.
- NAIDOC Round uniforms & flags display.
- Gift exchange with other club.

## Game Day

- Moment of reflection.
- Recognise First Nations Athletes.
- Cultural performance (dance, music, storytelling).
- Display First Nations Artwork / videos.

## Post-Game

- Thank Elders, players, families and visiting club.
  - Gather feedback and plan ongoing cultural education.
  - Consider fundraising or mentorship opportunities.
